Water Supply Lines

As the temperatures begin to decrease there will be a need to take precautions to prevent frozen pipes. Turn off the water supply to the unit whenever it will be unoccupied for more than 24 hours.

Maintain a minimum temperature of 55 degrees at all times. Replace your water heater at least every 10 years. Spending a few hundred dollars now is better than a few thousands if the heater fails and causes water damage.
