Water Damage

What an uncomfortable subject - but as Condo Owners it's one that we have to discuss! It is not uncommon to experience some type of water damage from the unit above yours. Common issues are A/C leaks, toilet overflows, dishwasher issues or a leak because the shower curtain wasn't pulled tight enough. The repairs can be expensive or you might just need a few ceiling tiles replaced. Please remember that whatever the case, it is a matter to be solved between unit owners - not the Condominium Office. Contact the unit owner above you causing the damage OR your insurance company. The condominium office can provide the unit owners contact information.





As required by the 7th Amendment to the Bylaws - Article XIV, from November 15 - March 15 owners need to:

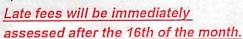
- √ Turn off the water supply to the unit whenever the unit will be unoccupied for more than 24 hours.
- ✓ Maintain a minimum temperature of 55 degrees at all times.
- ✓ Replace the water heater at least every 10 years.

Feel free to call the condo office if you need assistance with any of the above.



Condo Fees

Condo fee payments are due on the first of each month. The association depends on timely payment of assessments to maintain appropriate cash flow to properly manage the building and operate the association.

Dryer Vent Cleaning

As we begin preparing for the busy season make sure dryer vent cleaning is added to your checklist. If your vent is clogged with lint or otherwise obstructed (e.g. a birds nest or crushed vent) your clothes will take longer to dry and your dryer can overheat. If your laundry takes more than one cycle to dry your clothes it's time to act! We have arranged for Indoor Pollution Solutions to come out in February 12 - February 16 to service the condos. The normal price is \$125 but The Carousel receives a discount price of \$100. If we have 50 or more units that needs servicing, they will offer a group rate of \$60 per unit, payable directly to Indoor Pollution Solutions.

Payment will be collected prior to the service. Please contact Indoor Pollution Solutions directly to arrange the service.
